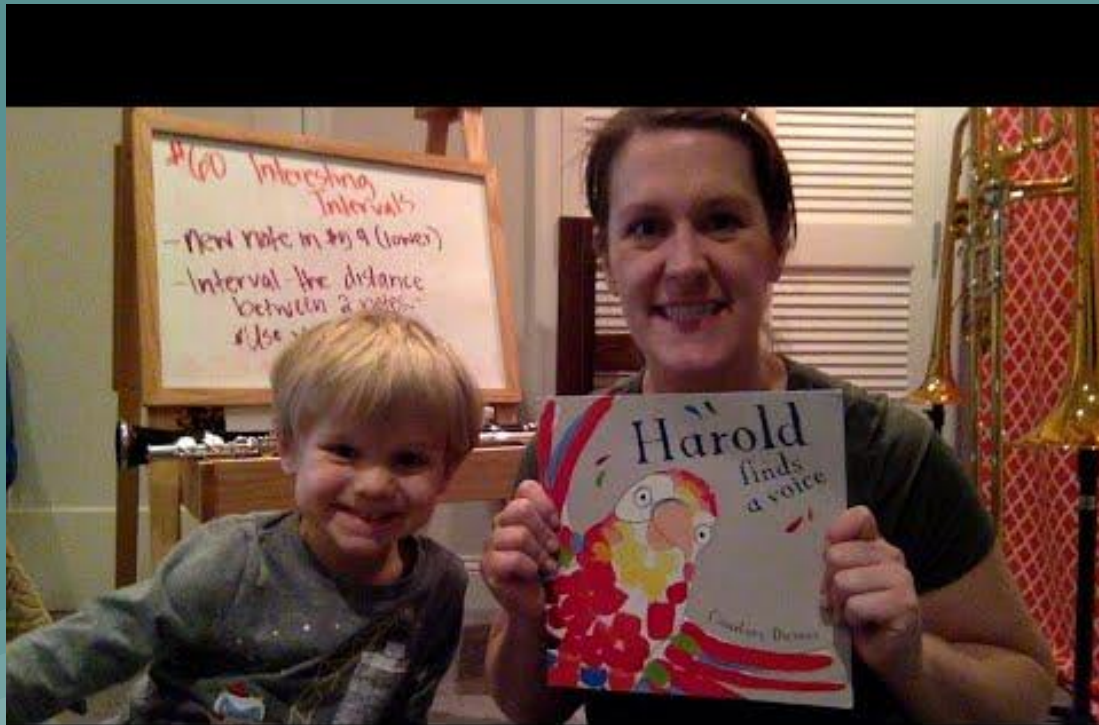

How To Speak MOO



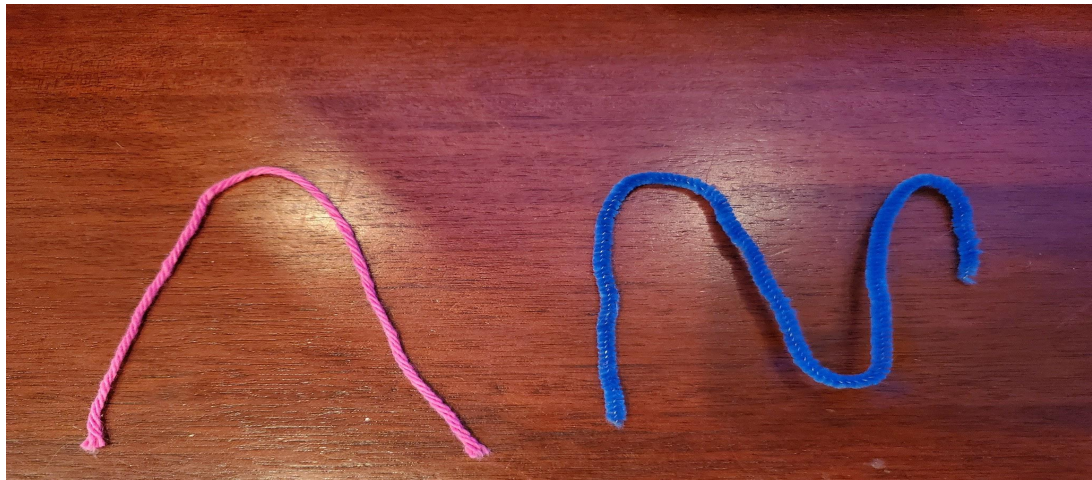
Create your own sounds.

“Voice Rollercoasters”

By using things around your house you can make high and low sounds.

By using a pipe cleaner (or string, piece of yarn, phone charger, ect.) you can create a “sound shape”. By laying it out like a rollercoaster (or waves) you can create high and low sounds. Create a “sound shape” and show me what it sounds like.

You can do the same thing by bouncing a ball. When the ball is in the air you have a high sound, when it is on the ground you have a low sound.
