### STEPS ... continued

2. Go outside and **gather** your natural materials.
3. Spend some time **considering** your arrangement. **Write** about what you are thinking and feeling before you start building. Be honest and put your heart into it.
4. **Take a picture** of your work stages during creation. Take a last picture of the finished work.
5. **Write** about what you were thinking and feeling during the creation process.
6. Then **write** about what you thought and felt upon completion while looking at your work.
